DOT Physical requirements effective immediately per DOT regulations:

ALL DRIVERS:

- 1. If you are on <u>ANY</u> medications; you must have the **name** of the medicine and **dosage** you take. This includes over the counter medicines.
- 2. You must have the full **name** and **address** of your treating **physician**(s), including any specialists that you see. As well as any surgeries performed in the last 6 months & a letter clearing you from work restrictions.

DO YOU HAVE SLEEP APNEA: \Box YES \Box NO IF YES SEE THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. Drivers with sleep apnea must bring in a letter from their treating physician stating that your problem is being treated and well controlled.
- 2. Some drivers who are significantly overweight will be required to undergo sleep apnea testing and treatment before getting a medical certificate.

DO YOU HAVE A HISTORY OF HEART DISEASE: \Box YES \Box NO IF YES SEE THE FOLLOWING:

1. You must have a letter from your cardiologist outlining any restrictions, your diagnosis, side effects of your medications and a copy of an EKG and stress test within the previous 24 months. Some conditions may require annual (yearly) stress testing or have other requirements.

DO YOU HAVE DIABETES: YES NO IF YES SEE THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. You must have a letter from the physician treating your diabetes that states that your condition is well controlled on your medications, that you are tolerating your medications without major side effects and a copy of an A1C performed within the last two months.
- 2. You must have a letter from your eye doctor from a recent eye exam documenting that you do not have any diabetic retinopathy. <u>This is an annual (yearly) requirement.</u>

THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS MAY REQUIRE FURTHER TESTING AT AN ADDITIONAL COST/ SEE MEDICAL RECEPTIONIST FOR COST

DO YOU SMOKE: \Box YES \Box NO IF YES SEE THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. If you are 35 years or older and smoke, you will also be required to undergo lung testing. If you do not meet minimum criteria, you will have to see a lung specialist for further testing before getting a medical certificate
- 2. Drivers with lung disease including asthma, COPD, emphysema or chronic bronchitis will also have to undergo the same testing.

DO YOU HAVE HEARING PROBLEMS: \Box YES \Box NO IF YES SEE THE FOLLOWING:

1. Drivers unable to pass a whisper hearing test will be required to have an audiometry hearing test.
